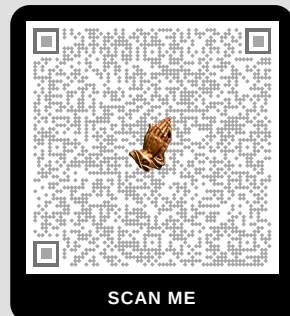
Truth to Power Your Journey

**“Men always ought to pray,
and not lose heart”**

Luke 18:1

Lose heart means to be weary or exhausted, that definitely describes a lot of our F.A.I.T.H Rider ministry. Especially when you live in the south and ride all the way to Sturgis, SD. What’s interesting here, in this verse, is that Jesus gives us the resource that’s needed, which can help us when we are tired. That resource is prayer. As F.A.I.T.H Riders prepare for our Sturgis SD outreach ministry, let’s use this great resource by once again participating in our 30 days of prayer. Ten days before the event (beginning July 28th), 10 days during the event (August 7th-16th) and 10 days after the event (August 17th-26th). You can go to our website for more information about this 30-day prayer time. Let me encourage you to also try to recruit help for the 10 days during the rally, by asking family members and friends, churches and chapters, to sign up for 1-hour slots from 7 am to 7 pm. This helps people participate in being a part of our ministry that can’t necessarily go themselves. Let me end with encouraging you with 1 John 5:14-15 which simply says that if we ask anything according to His will, He not only hears us, but we know that we have the petition we have asked of Him.

Road Captain’s Rally Point

Where direction, unity & purpose meet

**“Keep your eyes on Jesus,
the pioneer and perfecter of our faith.”**

Hebrews 12:2a

In motorcycle coaching we teach our students “you will go where you look.” It’s a basic driving and riding principle to remember in order to avoid target fixation. Target fixation occurs when an individual becomes so focused on an observed object that they inadvertently increase their risk of colliding with that object. That is, a person fixates on an object so intently they they steer in the direction of the object.

In truth, target fixation is a basic spiritual principle: we will move in the direction we are looking. The Scripture points us to the same reality in Hebrews 12:2, where the writer of Hebrews admonishes us to look toward Jesus, so that we move - in our spiritual growth - toward Him.

When riding, we need to make sure our gaze is on the road ahead to avoid target fixation. Remember, the most common single vehicle motorcycle accident is a motorcyclist failing to negotiate a curve. One of the contributing elements to such an accident is most often target fixation. A rider enters a corner too fast, and narrows his or her vision to a singular object - a guardrail, a telephone pole, a tree - and are unable to return their field of vision to the entire road, thus colliding with the object. It happens all the time.

So, when riding, even if you enter a curve too fast, resist focusing on any object off the road. Rather, keep your eyes looking through the curve, in the direction you want to go. And, in our spiritual life, let’s keep our eyes focused on Jesus. Because, spiritually, when we get our eyes off Jesus, we will end up crashing our walk with Jesus, which is far worse than crashing a motorcycle.

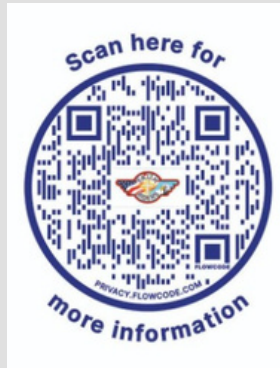

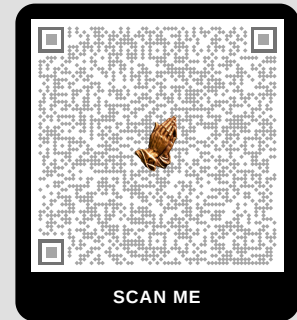
