## **"Conditional Promises"**

Have you ever noticed that most promises in the Bible are conditional promises? Promises like revival in 2 Chronicles 7:14, If my people.... then I will.... And Psalm 23, which reveals so many promises start off with a condition, "The LORD is my shepherd". Even our main ministry verse, 2 Peter 3:9 which is also a conditional promise, It's His will that none perish but all come to repentance.

As I was reading through Isaiah, chapter 44, verse 3 really began to speak to me. This verse reads (NKJV)

*"For I will pour water on him who is thirsty, and floods on the dry ground; I will pour My Spirit on your descendants, And My blessing on your offspring;"*

**Road Captain's Rally Point**  
**Where direction, unity & purpose meet**

**"Carry one another's burdens;  
in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ"**

**Galatians 6:2**

Shared burdens make for lighter loads. Paul reminds us that part of our responsibility as followers of Jesus is to "carry one another's burdens." That implies that we are to share our burdens with each other, so that we can pray for and encourage one another. And, in so doing, we lighten one another's load.

This passage is a great reminder that we can only carry so much on our own. What is true of us is also true of our motorcycles. As we enter the season of serious motorcycle travel, I see motorcycles with luggage piled dangerously high and deep rolling down the interstate. Others have so much stuff they've decided to pull a trailer behind their motorcycle, shifting the center of gravity from the way the motorcycle was engineered. There is a better way to proceed!

Dunlop is one of the leading manufacturers of motorcycle tires in the world. They have a handy "[load limit calculator](#)" that you can use to determine if your motorcycle is overloaded. When you are preparing for a trip, I recommend that you refer to the load limit calculator to determine if you are in danger of overloading your motorcycle. For my 2016 Ultra Limited, I have about 460 lbs available to "load." That includes me and my passenger in our full riding gear! So, on a solo trip, I have a maximum of about 210 lbs available for "luggage" – and that includes rain gear, tool kit, cleaning supplies, and anything else in my saddlebags. On a two-up trip, that maximum capacity shrinks to about 80 lbs.

On a motorcycle, the only thing sharing our burden is our bike. Do not overload it! And, make sure that what you do load is secure for the journey ahead. Remember, I am here to serve you and your chapter members. 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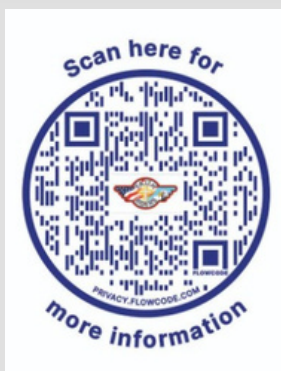
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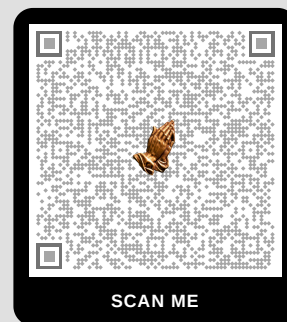
