Intentionally Praying

Intentional describes something done deliberately, on purpose, or with a clear plan or design, rather than accidentally. It implies a conscious choice to act and an vision of an intended outcome.

Intentionally praying means to approach prayer with deliberate purpose and focus, engaging in a conscious conversation with God rather than a rote or automatic act. This involves setting aside distractions, actively listening, expressing heartfelt praise and thankfulness, and aligning one's heart and actions with God's will.
