From My Heart

How do you trust Christ as YOUR Life? Glad you asked! I learned this from Dr. Bill Gillham author of "Lifetime Guarantee" and its what Watchman Nee called "The

Normal Christian Life." This is how trusting Christ to express His Life through you works.

The boss buzzes you and tells you to come into his office. He says that the report you submitted for the quarter was not acceptable and gives you a week to rewrite it. That's the sort of hell on earth that Christ has saved you from!

So, as you're sitting there with your heart in your throat – you are to think "Lord Jesus, I'm so glad that I don't have to do this rewrite. YOU are my life and this is YOUR baby. Thank You for saving me from this." You think that concept in a micro second. Then you say, "Yes, sir, Mr. Mulligan. I'll do my best. The problem will be fixed. You can count on it." Then you think, "Whew, Lord! You really do have a problem here. I'm so glad that I don't have to do this rewrite. Yes! The burden is the Lord's!

After this little scenario, you burn the midnight oil, highly motivated as your hands sometimes fly over, sometimes labor over the keyboard of your computer – trusting that Christ is doing this report for you, through you on a moment-by-moment basis. Yes! You don't go fishing and wait till you feel the Spirit of Christ take over and carry you to the computer terminal. You go sit at the keyboard. You save the document to a working file and then begin the rewrite job.

However, your faith is saying, "OK, Lord, where do WE begin? I don't have a clue." This, my friend is trusting Christ as life through you, by faith. Have YOU missed this piece in the salvation equation?

Christ as life comes right along with the package that you acquired when you got saved. Many of us have trusted Jesus as **Savior**; we've trusted Him as **Lord**, but may have never trusted Him as **LIFE** until we meet something which is absolutely beyond our ability. Trusting Christ as life is "[casting] your burden upon the Lord" (Psalm 55:22) which is a command, not an option.

God **commands** you to shove the burden of living on earth squarely onto the broad shoulders of your Savior and to keep piling it on HIM moment-by-moment. This may sound like a cop-out to you, but it's **NORMAL!** You were not saved to "carry your own weight." That's the devil's idea. Not only is this not noble, it's sin to carry your own weight! It's independence. God says, "Whatever [as in breathing God's air] is not from faith is sin" Romans 14:23b).

Backpack Ministry

Items to include in each backpack : Pencils, Crayola Crayons, Crayola washable markers, Crayola colored pencils, Scissors, Composition Notebooks for ages (5-8) Loose Leaf paper inside 1 inch white binder for ages (9-12), small school box, Clorox wipes, Germ X, Box of tissues. 1 special gift (toy, stuffed animal, etc.) Other items can be included. Backpacks will go to Clay County children in need. Foster children with DHR and the elementary schools will receive these backpacks.

Backpacks are due by July 15, 2019 at the CBA office.

Christmas Backpacks

We will partner with the church in North Georgia again to send backpacks to a poverty area in Mousie, Kentucky for Christmas. Items to include in these backpacks are: **Toys:** small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, small musical instruments, yo-yos, jump ropes, sidewalk chalk, card games. **School Supplies:**

Pens, pencils (with sharpener), erasers, crayons, colored pencils, markers, writing pads, notebooks, notebook paper, construction paper, coloring books.

Hygiene items: Toothbrush, toothpaste, mild bar soap, hair brush, comb, wash cloth, ponytail holders, hair clips, etc.

Other: children's bible– hard candy (no chocolate), double bag candy. Mints, pop-top cans of food– **Do not include items that can be easily crushed or broken, liquids or knives.**
