From My Heart

Annie Armstrong Easter Offering was started in 1895 by Woman's Missionary Union to benefit the Home Mission Board – now named

North American Mission Board. In 1934 the Offering was named in honor of Annie Armstrong a bold missions supporter and WMU's first national leader.

Annie was unstoppable in her passion for missions. She was born in Baltimore at a time when there was little opportunity for women. Yet her devotion to Jesus led her to a life of service and leadership. She organized women to pray, to give and to meet needs around them. She challenged pastors and churches to action and rallied support for missionaries.

The Week of Prayer for North American Missions is observed to pray for missionaries, their ministries and their families. Prayer is the fuel for spiritually sustaining missionaries in places where the gospel is greatly needed, but often opposed. North America is a mission field that needs the hope of the Gospel! NAMB is committed to taking this hope to cities, small towns and college campuses.

The AAEO is the primary way we support mission efforts in United States, Canada and US Territories: Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands, Guam and American Samoa. One Hundred percent of gifts given to the AAEO are used to support Southern Baptist missionaries serving across the United States and Canada.

The theme for AAEO is "It's All About the Gospel." The Scripture verse is First Corinthians 15:3-4, "For I passed on to you as most important what I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that He was buried, that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures." The national goal for AAEO is 70 million dollars.

For your information the mission field for NAMB has a population of 363 million people, speaking 350 different languages, with more than 14 religions and an estimated 273 million lost persons. Even in the traditional "Bible Belt" Christianity is being pushed to the margins. However, in the midst of this God is bringing the nations to our shores offering us unprecedented opportunities for the gospel!

Ultimately Annie Armstrong was recognized as a national Southern Baptist trailblazer for her visionary leadership that still inspires millions today. May your church be inspired to give generously to the AAEO this year! Bruce
