From My Heart

The Kickoff for the Week of Prayer for North American Missions and the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering will be Sunday March 7, 2021. This year's theme is **"The Mission Moves Forward."** The national goal is 70 Million Dollars Convention wide. Every gift from every individual and every congregation goes 100% to train, resource and send thousands of missionaries across the United States, Canada and their territories. **1 Corinthians 15:58** is the scriptural basis, "Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the Lord's work, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain."

In order for the Mission to Move Forward I believe in this day of COVID 19, we need a reminder of what the Mission is! The Apostle Peter reminds us in **1 Peter 2:9-10** that "The Mission is Still the Same!" In so doing, he points out **The Past Mission** by saying in verse 10 "Who in time past." God initiated His great redemptive mission of repentance and forgiveness in the Old Testament by calling Abraham. God called him in Genesis 12:1-3 to be His person on mission, to be a blessing. Then God called a people through Moses in Exodus 19:3-6 to be on mission with Him and to represent Him in this world.

Peter also puts **God's Mission in the Present** as verse 10 goes on to say, "but are now the people of God..." The past mission is brought into the present here by Peter. The purpose for which you and I were brought into a relationship with God is outlined in verse 9... The mission moves forward as we become a privileged people, a priestly people, a purposeful people and a personal people for God – a people of God's own!

"The Mission Moves Forward" by me and you and our churches, Being and Doing, what God saved us and called us to Be and Do: Call people out of sin, Call people to Jesus and Come together to communicate His praises! Let's you and I be recommitted to moving the mission of the Messiah, Jesus the Christ forward
