CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Students must go to all scheduled events including Worship Studies, Family Group times, Bible Group, Quiet Time, and activities. Please review the schedule for each day.

LIGHTS OUT WILL BE AT 11:30 each night. This means each student must be in their room and in bed by this time. After 11:30 dorm rooms and dorm halls will be locked and students will be unable to leave without contacting an adult chaperons.

Cell Phones and Electronic devices can only be used during free times. This is when you will need to contact your parents and check in each day. Electronic devices are not to be used during Bible study time etc... you can use your phones to take pictures during worship service etc... but must put them up when it is time for the Bible lesson.

NO ALCOHOL, DRUGS, TOBACCO, WEAPONS, ETC... ARE ALLOWED ON CAMPUS AT ANY TIME

Meal scheduled must be followed, meals are served at a certain time and once the time is over the cafeteria closes. Please be sure to be up and ready to go eat breakfast ON TIME each morning!

No clothing that promotes drugs, alcohol, tobacco, sex, or other inappropriate topics are allowed.

Shorts must be proper length and shirts must not be revealing.

Students must use the buddy system and never go anywhere on campus alone. You must always have at least 1 other student with you and fully inform your chaperons where you are going and why.
