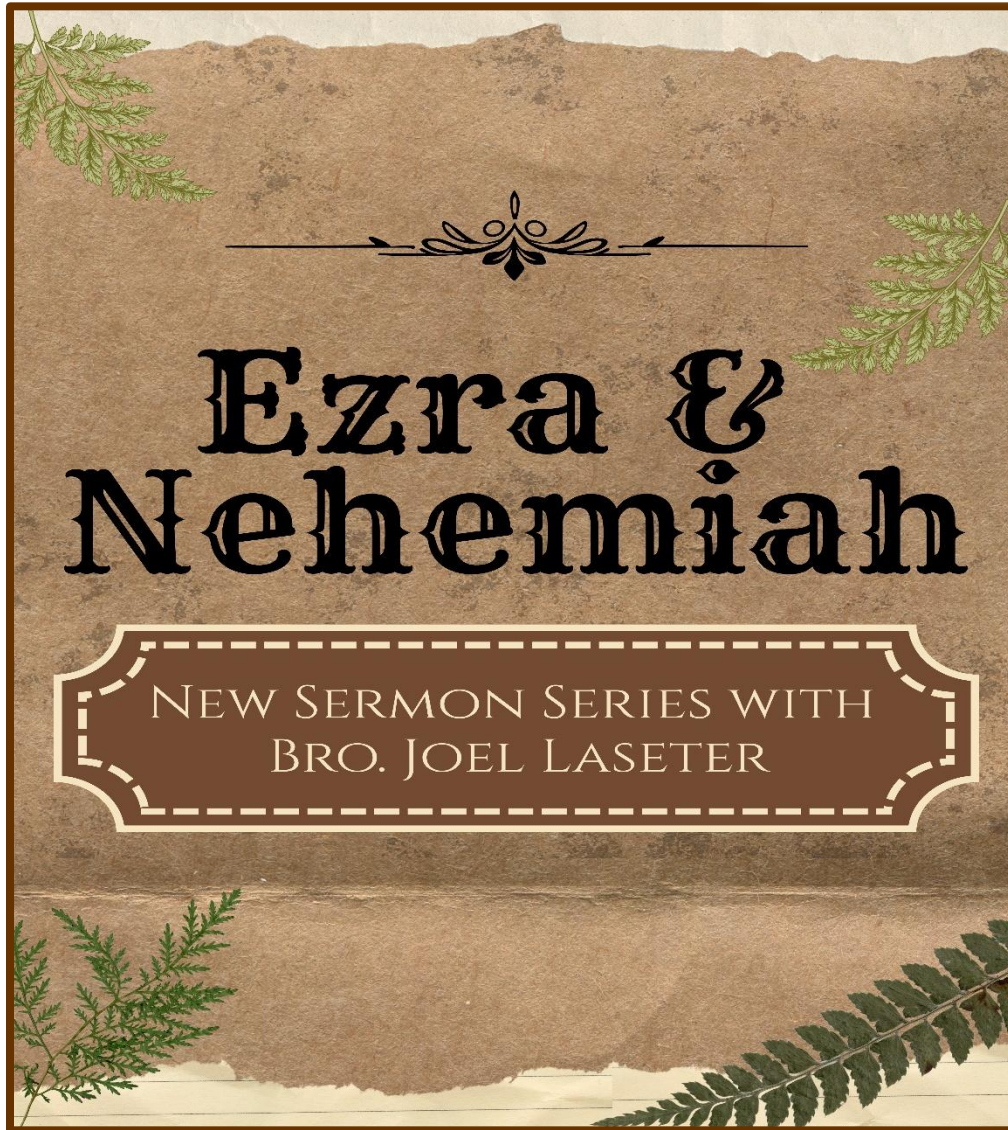

Last week we began a new study through Romans. Paul began his letter by addressing the Gentiles who had turned toward the created rather than the Creator, saying they had no excuse. In chapter 2, Paul turned his attention to the Jews, reminding them that they were also without excuse because all people are sinners before God. He shows no partiality toward Jew or Gentile—all will be judged according to their response to Him.

As you prepare for our discussion this week, reflect on your own life and your response to God's Word. Have you relied on knowledge rather than obedience in your spiritual life? How can you move from hearing God's truth to actively obeying it? We hope you will join us for our discussion on Romans 2:1-13 this week!
